Hazeldean Road Aluminum Banner



The winners of the [Hazeldean Road](#) public art contest will bring a new look to the west-end road by designing artwork that will adorn light poles and beautify the landscape. Winning designs by artist Jennifer Stead and artist teams of Lynda Cronin and Eric Chan, and Alisdair MacRae and Negar Seyfollahy were selected for the 82 aluminum banners that will highlight the Kanata West and Stittsville communities.

Jennifer Stead's *Narrative of Nature* celebrates the dramatic environment surrounding Kanata. Thirty-six banners will form a narrative of contrasting and evolving motifs and patterns that depict the movement of the natural world.

Lynda Cronin and Eric Chan's project of 26 banners in Kanata West will focus on the upbeat nature of that community. Themes of their designs include: the environment, commerce, communications, culture and hi-tech. Each of these themes speaks to the unique nature of Kanata today while celebrating anticipated growth.

Alisdair MacRae and Negar Neyfollahy poetically reconnect urban travellers with nature's guidance systems. *Imprint: Intersections of City & Sky* will be installed in Stittsville as a series of 20 designs drawing attention to visible constellations in the north-eastern and south-western sky along Hazeldean Road.
